The Loveland Initiative Tracy Johnson Scholarship One (1) \$1500.00 Scholarship Available This Year

TRACY JOHNSON: Through her struggle with muscular dystrophy, Tracy Johnson (2/18/72-2/7/2000) demonstrated courage and perseverance to further her educational goals. She attended Loveland high school for two years and transferred to the Cincinnati academy of physical education where her physical needs could be better met. She was involved in many activities such as girl scouts, cheerleading, and modeling for the Barbizon school.

Upon graduation, Tracy enrolled at Wright state university to study sociology but had to abandon these plans when she encountered challenges with physical care away from home. Not to be deterred, she transferred to Raymond Walters College to continue her dream of a college education. Heart problems (a complication of her illness) forced her to postpone her dream. With continued perseverance, and only five months before her death, Tracy enrolled at Raymond Walters a second time. Her illness once again (her third try) forced her to abandon her college dreams. Her uncle Milton said, "Tracy just wanted to learn." In honor of Tracy's strength and courage and her lifelong desire to go to college, this scholarship will carry her name.

The Loveland Initiative Tracy Johnson Scholarship is funded by money raised during The Loveland Initiative's annual "Christmas Toy Store" event. The Scholarship places emphasis on financial need, community service, and academic achievement.

Recipient Criteria:

- Must be a **2020** high school graduate residing in the Loveland School District. (This includes a diploma from any State of Ohio Department of Education certified secondary program, including but not limited to home school and parochial schools if the student resides in the Loveland School District.)
- Must provide proof of enrollment in an accredited post-secondary institution by Fall Term **2020** (required before disbursement of scholarship monies to the recipient's chosen institution).
- Must meet the income guidelines included with the application packet and provide verification of that fact.
- Must submit a **completed application Packet** to the Loveland Initiative's Executive Director via email trogers7@fuse.net by Thursday **March 19, 2020**, at **5:00 p.m.** which must include:
 - ✓ The completed application forms
 - ✓ Two letters of recommendation from adults who know you well but are not relatives (preferably from teachers, school administrators, counselors, employers, clergy, coaches, etc.).
 - ✓ An official copy of your most recent high school transcripts.
 - ✓ Typed-written response to one (1) of the three (3) essay questions found on the application.

- 2-3 pages minimum in length
- Typed, double-spaced, and 12 point font
